Chintpurni is a small town in the Una district of Himachal Pradesh about 40 km (25 miles) north of Una,

The legend behind this Shakti Peetha is part of the Shaktism tradition which tells the story of the self-immolation of the goddess Sati. Vishnu had to cut her body into 51 body parts, which fell on Earth and became sacred sites.

The Chinnamastika Devi is a divine embodiment of self-sacrifice and there by Mata Chintpurni ji is considered as a Shakti Peetha. It is believed that Charan (Feet) of Godess Sati fell at this place.






VAISHNO DEVI

The Vaishno Devi Temple is an important Hindu temple dedicated to Vaishno Devi located at Trikuta Mountains in jammu. The temple is one of the 108 Shakti Peethas dedicated to Durga, who is worship as Vaishno Devi. It is one of the most visited pilgrimage centers of India. Every year millions of visitors visit the temple. During festivals like Navaratri, the count even increases to one crore visitors. Banganga, Charanpaduka, Ardkuwari, Sanjhichhat, Bhairovnath temple and Maa Vaishno Devi Shrine are the main place of warship on the way from Katra to Shrine.






BHIMA KALI (SARAHAN)






DEOTH SIDH BABA BALAK NATH

SHRI CHAMUNDA JI

This ancient temple is said to have been constructed in the 16th century and has considerable spiritual legend attached to it. It is one of the most famous temples in India. The Chamunda Devi Temple has always been a tourist attraction for people who visit Kangra. The temple attracts travellers from all parts of India, not only because there are a lot of spiritual legends attached to it, but also because the temple is ancient and because of its Himachali architecture.

The ancient idol of Shri Chamunda Devi is a common subject of interest among travellers, photographers and devotees alike. Apart from the plenty of tourists who visit the Chamunda Devi Temple as a major tourist attraction A small temple named Jakhni Mata Mandir is situated on a hilltop that overlooks the valley. It is accessible by a short mountain drive.






SHERABLING NEAR BHATTU, BAIJNATH) KANGRA



TABO/DHANKAR/KAZA MONASTERY

Tabo Monastery – sometimes referred to as the Ajanta of the Himalayas – is the oldest earthen Buddhist monastery in the Himalayan region to have survived unchanged and comparatively well intact. It was established over 1,000 years ago. Today, the old temple site is made up of nine temples and several stupas, in addition to cave shrines along the mountain slope. The shrines are decorated with murals and are traditionally used for meditation. A new assembly hall, the Kalachakra Temple, was built for the first Kalachakra initiation carried out by His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama in Tabo in 1983, and a Kalachakra stupa was inaugurated in 2009.

HARIDWAR

Haridwar is one of the seven sacred cities of the Hindus and is a major pilgrimage centre. It has been known by many names; originally it was called Kapila, for the sage who once lived there. Haridwar's chief object of pilgrimage is Har-ki-pauri—the bathing ghat, or steps, along the river—which has what believers consider to be a footprint of Vishnu impressed into a stone. Large numbers of pilgrims gather there annually at the beginning of the Hindu solar year in April; the Kumbh Mela (a Hindu religious festival) is held every 12th year in Haridwar. The Daksha Mahadev temple, another important pilgrimage site, lies 2 miles (3 km) downstream at Kankhal. Devout believers feel that they can go to heaven by getting their salvation after a dip in the sacred Ganga at Haridwar.




MANIKARAN (KULLU)

Manikaran is located in the Parvati Valley on river Parvati, northeast of Bhuntar in the Kullu District of Himachal Pradesh. Manikaran is a pilgrimage centre for Hindus and Sikhs. The Hindus believe that Manu recreated human life in Manikaran after the flood, making it a sacred area. It has many temples and a Gurudwara. There are temples of the Hindu deities Rama, Krishna, and Vishnu. The area is well known for its hot springs and its beautiful landscape.



















MAA BHANGAYANI (HARIPURDHAR)

Maa Bhangayani is known to be the most powerful goddess of Himachal Pradesh's Sirmour district. According to the legends, Shirgul Maharaj was imprisoned by a Mughal king of that time who was frightened by Maharaj's spiritual powers. With the blessings of Maa Bhangyani, the king of Bagad and Guga peer helped him to gain freedom. This incident has been enlisted in golden chapters and since then Maa Bhangayani has been celebrated as god sister of Shirgul Mahadev.











The Vajreshwari temple is located in the town of Kangra, Kangra district, Himachal Pradesh, India and is 3 km away from both the railway stations of Kangra Mandir and Kangra of Kangra City. Kangra Airport is just 9 kilometers from the temple.


